### Terms and Conditions for March Break Camp Fees:

1. All prices are in Canadian dollars and all taxes are included.
  2. The price for the camp programs include lift tickets and full supervision for 5 days of camp, it does NOT include lessons.
  3. All beginners must take lessons for at least the first 2 days to reach a reasonable level to join a group. Beginners who do not book lessons will not ski/snowboard for the day and no refunds will be made.
  4. A non-refundable \$100 deposit and \$3 registration fee is needed to book the camp. The \$100 deposit is credited towards the payment of the camp fees.
  5. **Cancellation Policy:**
    - a. Fees at Ecolart are specific to each different program and they are subject to change without notice.
    - b. Cancellations requested 30 days or more before the start of the registered session, all camp fees are fully refundable minus a \$50 cancellation fee.
    - c. Cancellations requested 29 to 15 days before the start of the registered session are eligible for credit refunds only.
    - d. All cancellations requested 14 days before the start of the registered session are not eligible neither for refund nor for credit.
    - e. A minimum enrolment is needed in order to run a given program. Ecolart reserves the right to cancel any program that does not meet minimum enrolment. In this case, the camper will receive a full refund of the program fees, or they can transfer the fees towards enrolment in a different camp program in the same or different week.
- \*Transportation** is on a school bus departing from Montreal to Ski Bromont and back to the same stop. Any changes of bus stop may be subject to extra charges.
- \*\*Lunch Plan** is served and delivered by a local restaurant, we do not offer special meals such as vegetarian, kosher, halal and such, and cannot guarantee food free of allergies.
- \*\*\*Equipment rental** will be given to the child on Monday at the ski hill, each camper must take all their equipment home every day and return it complete on Friday afternoon at the ski hill. Each camper is responsible for paying in case of loss or damage of their equipment. Skiing equipment includes skis, poles, boots and helmet. Snowboarding equipment includes board, boots and helmet.
- \*\*\*\* Valet service** keeps your skis/board at camp so you don't have to bring them back home every day.
- \*\*\*\*\*Beginner lessons** are given in group by certified instructors provided by Ski Bromont. Individual lessons may be requested subject to availability and will be charged at the rate indicated by Ski Bromont.
